This is an extraordinary opportunity for an educator to play a critical role in directing De Marillac's progress toward breaking the cycle of poverty through education.

Inspired by the Daughters of Charity and De La Salle Christian Brothers, De Marillac Academy provides a life-changing, accessible Catholic educational experience for the children, youth and families of the Tenderloin and SoMa neighborhoods. We believe that neighborhood of residence and socioeconomic status should not determine a child's access to quality education or ultimate success in life. De Marillac Academy's holistic educational experience liberates students to lead lives of choice, meaning, and purpose, and therefore transforms the Tenderloin and beyond.

De Marillac accompanies low-income families through an innovative and comprehensive school program and a dynamic graduate support program that continues through high school and beyond. All students attend De Marillac Academy on a full, annual scholarship. In 2017-18, De Marillac Academy is proud to serve 115 fourth through eighth grade students, 278 alumni through the Graduate Support Program, and over 230 school families through our unique wrap-around clinical and family support program.

The Lead Middle-School Teacher has the responsibility to guide and instruct students as they meet the demands and rigors of middle-school curriculum and experiences. Lead teaching responsibilities will include Language Arts, Social Studies, and Religion, but are flexible based on skills and qualifications of the candidate and the middle-school teaching team, along with the needs of the school. The teacher also schedules and facilitates class meetings and conferences with families. Responsibilities include supervision of breaks/lunches and attendance at events/activities throughout the school year. This role requires the ability to collaborate and communicate with teachers across multiple grade levels and content areas. Teachers are expected to prioritize student engagement through various learning activities, including the ability to effectively integrate educational technology and analysis of data across the curriculum as part of our Personalized Learning program.

The ideal candidate will possess relevant classroom experience; strong interpersonal, written, and verbal communication skills; flexibility; comfort with a variety of tasks/roles; and a commitment to Catholic education. The teacher is an integral member of the teaching team in developing and enhancing established curriculum, as well as modeling a culture of learning and professionalism at De Marillac Academy.
