Knowledge of STEM curriculum implementation will contribute to important school-wide instructional initiatives, including the ability to implement high quality, engaging project-based, multi-disciplinary instructional units aligned with Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) and Math Common Core Standards.

Teachers hold responsibility for the implementation of the curriculum and the academic success of every student.
