

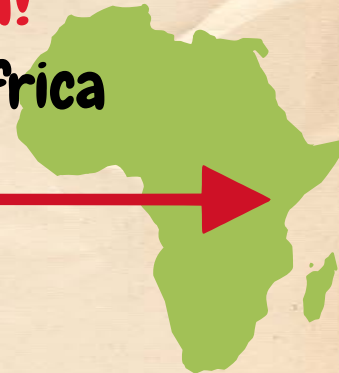

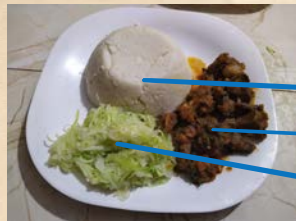
Located in East Africa

Green Stripe: Kenya's lush landscape

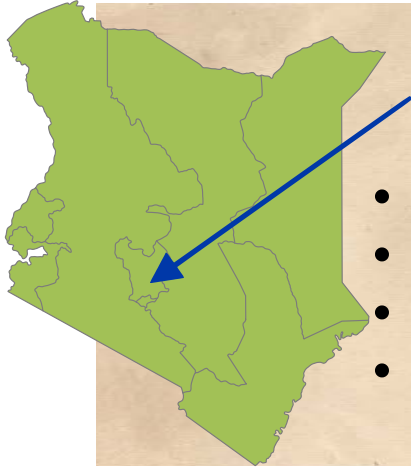
White stripes: peace, honesty, purity, and innocence
